









Acceptable Residential SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING Material List


What to recycle:

How to recycle it:

Please DON'T recycle:

	Plastic bottles, jars, tubs and buckets (up to 3 gallons in size) made of #1 and #2 plastic (as shown at left)	Discard screw top caps, rinse and place container and lids in your recycling bin.	NO PLASTIC BAGS OF ANY KIND Automotive fluids (motor oil, antifreeze, windshield washer, etc.) containers Medicine bottles Toys Foam plastics Take-out Food trays Black plastic of any kind Film plastics such as plastic wrap, grocery bags, dry cleaning bags and trash bags Plastic or plastic-coated paper plates and cups
	Examples include milk jugs, soda bottle, cooking oil bottles, water bottles, laundry detergent jugs, cat litter buckets.	Remove metal handles from buckets. Redeem deposit bottles!	
	Food-grade packaging! Examples include laundry detergent jugs, shampoo bottles, dish detergent and skin cream containers.	Discard screw top caps, rinse and place containers and lids in your recycling bin.	
	Food-grade packaging! Examples include squeezable condiment bottles and food storage container.		
	Food-grade packaging! Examples include yogurt, margarine, butter, sour cream, pudding and cottage cheese containers, as well as ketchup and mustard bottles.		
	Food-grade packaging! Solid plastics only (no foam plastics).		
	Food-grade packaging! Examples include large water bottles up to 3 gallons, food containers and Tupperware.		








Now! Recycle large rigid plastic items!

	Toys, beverage crates, laundry baskets, large buckets, storage containers	Remove and recycle plastic wheels and metal handles, axles, hinges, fasteners	Mirror glass, black plastic containers that held hazardous materials

What if I have **single-stream recycling**?


Just place them in your recycling bin or barrel with your paper, cardboard, metal and glass recyclables.

And don't forget to recycle all these other materials!

	Newspaper, junk mail, catalogs, magazines, home computer paper		Dirty or contaminated material, Tyvek mailing envelopes, gift wrap, greeting cards
	Now! Telephone books and hard-cover books		Please don't recycle more than two phone books at a time. This will keep our processing equipment running efficiently.
	Corrugated cardboard		Dirty or contaminated material, <u>pizza boxes</u> , plastic or wax-coated cardboard, cereal boxes, shoe boxes, other types of boxes
	Glass bottles and jars (up to 2.5 gallons in size)		Window glass, light bulbs, mirrors, medicine bottles, broken glass, bottles and jars larger than one gallon REDEEM DEPOSIT BOTTLES!
	Aluminum cans, food trays and foil.	Rinse and place in your recycling bin, Fold foil flat.	Pots, pans, coat hangers, toys, other metal items - REDEEM DEPOSIT BOTTLES!
	Steel food (up to No.10 size) and beverage cans including aerosol cans	Discard lids, rinse and place in your recycling bin	Pots and pans, coat hangers, appliances, toys, other metal items
	Boxboard (cereal boxes, pasta boxes, shoe boxes, shirt cardboard)	Discard plastic or wax-paper inner bags, remove plastic windows and flatten, then place in the same bundle or bag with your newspapers, junk mail and other mixed paper	Dirty or contaminated material. Plastic-coated paper or cardboard materials such as plates and cups. Pizza boxes are frequently made of this material but are not accepted.

What if I have **single-stream recycling**?

It's easier than ever! No need to tie paper and cardboard into separate bundles -- just place them in your recycling bin or barrel with your cans, bottles and other recyclables.

	Aseptic packaging (milk cartons, juice boxes) up to one gallon in size	Discard straws or caps, then rinse and place in your recycling bin.
